1. We wrapped our final week of Esther last week. Did you enjoy reading though the book of Esther as a LifeGroup?
2. How were your devotions this past week? What have you been reading about?

Connect

1. Who is a Star Wars fan?
2. What were you expecting out of this first week of 'At the Movies'?
3. What was the major theme that we can see in the movie for this week?
4. We talked about how Satan is real and that we don't often speak about how he has plans. In your Christian journey, have you struggled to grasp the enemy (Satan) is real? Why or why not?

Engage

1. Read John 10:10, 1 Peter 5:8, Hebrews 11:1
2. What do all these verses have in common?
3. "All rebellions are built on hope." 1 Peter 5:8. Satan has a lot of bark, but he cannot hurt us. He hopes that he can but he cannot. Share a time when it looked like you would be hurt, defeated, but God came through.

Next Steps

1. A next step that you can take this week is going deeper into God's word, and by increasing your prayer life. There is a battle going on so we need to be prepared. Brain storm as a group how you can read your bible and pray more this week. Be intentional and come up with a game plan. (ideas: read a book of the bible together, take prayer requests and give them to people to pray for at the same time each day, etc)
2. Memorize Hebrews 11:1
3. Next week we'll be taking a look at the story 'Lion' is there a friend you could invite?

Pray

Try praying the same way we did last week again: We often pray by continually talking the whole time, then say amen, and move on to the next prayer. Prayer is often compared to a conversation. After you are done praying and before you say amen pause for 20 seconds and listen for God, then say amen. Often when we listen, we don't hear an audible voice, we feel a prompting or sense a feeling. This is God's Holy Spirit. If you don't sense anything don't be concerned. This is a good exercise simply to remind us that God can speak and we should listen.
