Reflect - *How does this week's teaching affect me personally?*

1. Justification is all about being put in right relationship with God. When we unite our lives with Jesus, we are justified and brought into right relationship with Him. Is this something that you feel that you have? If yes, how does it feel to know that you have been justified? If no, is this something that you long for?
2. Sanctification is a process by which Jesus is transforming you to be more and more like Him. Is this a process that you feel you are a part of? Are you able to compare your life before you met Jesus, to your life after you met Him?
3. Glorification is the promise that we will one day be made complete in Jesus. What does the hope of glorification look like for you? How does it change the way that you live your life?

Next Steps - *Let's try to apply this.*

- **Let go of the past.** If there is something that you are holding on to from your past take some time to recognize that God is not holding on to it. Justification means that you are put in right relationship with God, and He is not holding on to your past mistakes.
- **Press into being a reflection of Jesus.** Each and every day we have an opportunity to look more like Jesus. Challenge yourself with something each day, and it will become second nature to you.
- **Anticipate that you will one day be made complete.** As failures arise (and they will come up), remember that there will be a day when they will be no more. Hold onto that hope and allow it to be motivation to press into life with Jesus.
