### Study - What does the Bible say?

Think through/discuss some of these questions as you read through Scripture:

- [Acts 4:20](#) - Have you ever felt this way about anything in your life? What did that look like? Have you ever felt this way about your faith in Jesus? What does that look like?
- [Acts 1:8](#) - What do you think it means to be a "witness" for Jesus? How do you go about practically doing this?
- [Acts 20:24](#) - With the many things life throws at us, how do you continue to make this a priority in your life?
- [1 Peter 3:15](#) - What does "being prepared" look like for you?

### Reflect - How does this week's teaching affect me personally?

1. What are some experiences that you have had that you feel the need to share with others? Why do you think it is difficult for us to do this with our experience of church?
2. Even though there are many things that pull us apart, we are all united by our faith in Jesus. How have you seen this pull you together with people that are "different" than you?
3. What are some of the risks that you see with church going forward? How do you think God is calling you to conquer fear?
4. What are some of the responsibilities that you feel God is giving you? How are you going to step up in these areas?
5. Has God impacted your life through the ministry of Southgate? In what ways? How can you share your story?

### Next Steps - Let's try to apply this.

- **In this new season of ministry, what is your role? What is God leading you to do?** As a church we all will need to take on new roles and responsibilities, ask God to show you what He wants you to step into.
- **Take the risk. It might be to give. It might be to lead. It might be to invite.** Often following Jesus means sacrifice and risk, what things might God be asking you to risk or sacrifice?
- **Stop focusing on your issues, and focus on your role in unifying Southgate.** No church is perfect, and you may have personal issues with the church. Focusing on the issues will always bring about division. Focusing on solutions and steps in the right direction will bring about unity.
